Canfield Township Trustees held a workshop in the Canfield Township Hall on Thursday, April 7, at 9:04am. This was noticed in *The Vindicator, an edition of the Tribune Chronicle* on April 7, 2022 as required by the Ohio Sunshine Law.

Also present was Fiscal Officer Denise Joseph, Township Administrator/Road Superintendent Keith Rogers and Zoning Inspector Traci DeCapua.

The Board discussed many different topics including: The new Comprehensive Land Use Plan revisions to the first 33 pages; advertising on *indeed* for a full-time Public Works Department employee; confirming street sweeping is scheduled for the week of April 25; adding Bent Willow to this year's paving program which will be scheduled around street sweeping, and checking with the Prosecutor's Office to see what services the Township has to charge the School District for loading rock salt.

Mr. Governor will convey comments to the Mahoning County Prosecutor's Office regarding the Lease Agreement with the Cardinal Joint Fire District.

Mr. Rogers will check with the City of Canfield to see if they have scheduled times allowing fireworks to take place since fireworks are now legal in Ohio on certain holidays.

**Next Meeting Date(s):** The Board will have three meetings on April 26, 2022; (1) public meeting to discuss the Messerly Road property at 5:30pm; (2) public hearing on the street lighting district at 6:15pm; and (3) regular meeting at 7:00pm. These meetings are scheduled to be in person at the Township Hall and will be advertised appropriately.
